APRIL: Income: \$5891, Exp: \$1654, Bal: \$13,900.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Volunteer: Ann Beacht reported in the May meeting that she had turned in a total of 802 hours to the County which translated to a total of +\$17000 towards rent of the Artspace.

Membership: There are now 100 members.

Program: The Veterans' Showcase is set for several events in May with a special presentation by the Experimental Theater Company headed by Nathan and Paige Young

Grant: The group has completed the Community Foundation application. Chris Jones reported that Tony Burnett and Sandra Purrington have offered to help with grant writing. The NM Cultural grant app has a December deadline.

Fundraising: Sue Kent is heading up a fundraising event set for mid-June that includes an ice cream social and silent auction with items donated by members and community businesses


Budget: The Board approved the 23/24 Budget which will be presented at the annual meeting for approval.

Cloudcroft Art Workshops has a long history in Otero County beginning all the way back to the 60s under the leadership of Jan Herring, member of a prominent El Paso family with a turn-of-the-century cabin near the Lodge Pro Shop.

After the Herrings, local (High Rolls) artist Sara and husband Joe Chambers hosted nationally-known art instructors for one-week art workshops at their Mountain Majesty Art Workshops in Cloudcroft, New Mexico, for five years.

In 1994, OAI member Linda Carter moved to Cloudcroft and built the Burro Street Boardinghouse. Well-known El Paso artist/teacher Bill Herring (son of Jan Herring) would stay with Linda at the Boardinghouse and through their acquaintance, Linda became involved with the Art Workshops and a member of the Cloudcroft Art Society. She and friends, Carolyn Sharp and May Jo Gusset, took over after the Chambers left; and today she and other OAI members Maria Tieman and Loynda Jones, along with Jerry Crump and Alicia Boettcher have been spearheading the Workshops which provide a much-appreciated addition to the tourism industry in Cloudcroft. Linda lives near Lake Travis, TX and spends her summers in Cloudcroft, enjoying the cool temps and mountain vibes.




